



INTERNATIONAL WIDOW'S DAY 20 JUNE 2014 AT KHOLOKOE TRADITIONAL COUNCIL

The International Widow's Day (IWD) is celebrated globally on 23 June in solidarity with widows and their children around the world who suffer various social injustices such as poverty, illiteracy, abuse etc. It was initially launched by the Loomba Foundation at the House of Lords in London in 2005 by Shrimati Pushpa Wati Loomba who became a widow on 23 June. On 22 December 2010, the United Nations General Assembly adopted resolution 65/189 and declared 23 June as International Widow's Day.

In collaboration with the Free State House of Traditional Leaders, Kholokoe Traditional Council will celebrate International Widow's Day on 20 June 2014 with a total of fifty (50), widows invited from Qwaqwa, Vrede, Thaba Nchu and Kholokoe.
